Eight nights and **seven days of wonder**, delight and inspiration. Traveling in a comfortable private touring bus (coach), we will start in London and chart a course through some of the most beautiful English countryside imaginable, stopping in at some notable gurdwaras along the way. Windsor Castle (family home of Queen Elizabeth), Winchester, Stonehenge, Glastonbury, Bath, South Wales, Warrick Castle, Stratford-upon-Avon, the Cotswolds and Oxford are the main stops. But there will be many small detours along the way and time to explore down narrow lanes with rows of curious-looking Tudor-style shops. In Stratford-upon-Avon we will attend a performance of a play by the Royal Shakespeare Company. Six scheduled kirtan programs at gurdwaras throughout Britain will bring us deep into the heart of the Khalsa experience in the UK – giving us a chance to exchange joy and energy with our Sikh brothers and sisters through the singing of kirtan.

All accommodation will be at quality hotels with some having a distinctly British charm, while others being of a more familiar Western style. Most meals will be provided and a group morning sadhana will be available.

Airfare is not included in the tour price but can be arranged through a central group booking agent with American Airlines where up to 15% discounts may be available.
